## The Napier Sailing Club has established the following Membership Terms and Conditions that members are expected to adhere to:

- 1. **Boat Identification**: Members must prominently display the name of their boat on the A-frame of their trailer.
- 2. **Speed Limit and No Wake**: Members must adhere to a 5-knot speed limit in the channel and approach the launching ramps at no wake to ensure safety and minimize disruption to others.
- 3. **Barrier Entrance Cards**: Members are not allowed to share their barrier entrance cards with others or use them to grant access to non-members.
- 4. **Parking Limit**: Each member is permitted to park only one vehicle with a trailer on-site during each visit. This helps manage limited parking space.
- 5. **Property Respect**: Members must not abuse or cause damage to NSC property. This includes not manually forcing the barrier gate open and not powering up/down onto their trailers at the launching ramps, which could potentially damage the facilities.
- 6. **Designated Parking Areas**: Members must park only in designated parking areas to ensure efficient use of parking space.
- 7. **Ramp Usage**: Members with power boats are instructed to use the front ramps specifically, the North beach ramp is for club ribs Only.
- 8. **Waste Disposal**: Members are prohibited from bringing household waste onto the NSC site with the intention of disposing it in NSC waste bins.
- 9. **Recycling Responsibility**: Members are encouraged to read recycling labels displayed at the recycle bins to ensure they are recycling responsibly, promoting environmentally friendly practices.
- 10. **Wash Down Facilities**: Members are asked to be considerate of all Members, wash down Facilities are for rinsing Vessels and Gear down not a full Valet Service as a Community organisation we pay for every Litre of water consumed.
